Introduction	This is a full scholarship established by the Ministry of Education to support Chinese universities to attract outstanding international students for graduate studies in China. CUG is one of the prestigious universities designated to undertake this program to recruit graduate students for Master and Doctoral Programs .
Eligibility	Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health.; Applicants must -be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs; -be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs.
Scholarship	Tuition waiver; free on-campus accommodation; living stipend (Master student: 3000RMB/month; Ph.D.
Coverage	student: 3500RMB/month); free medical insurance
Application Procedures	 Submit online application through the CSC Online Application System: http://www.campuschina.org/. (Choose Type B) Download the application form and print out ONE copy after filling in. CUG (Wuhan) Agency Code: 10491 Send all the required application documents (ONE copy) to the university before the deadline (March 15th).
Application Documents	1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (filled in Chinese or English); 2. Notarized highest diploma (photocopy, notarized in Chinese or English); 3. Academic transcripts (notarized in Chinese or English); 4. A Study Plan or Research Proposal with a minimum of 800 words (in Chinese or English); 5. Two Recommendation Letters from two professors or associate professors; 6. Foreigner's Physical Examination Form (photocopy); 7. Valid passport photocopy (TWO copies); 8. Valid HSK Certificate or TOFEL/IELTS Certificate; 9. ONE clear soft copy of your photo (uploaded onto the CSC application system); 10. Other supporting documents (e.g. CUG Supervisor's Recommendation Form for Excellent International Students, award certificates, academic papers, publications, etc.)
Language Requirement	1. Applicants for Chinese-taught programs should pass the HSK 4 test with a score no less than 200. Applicants with a HSK 4 score no less than 180 but could not meet the language requirement of CUG must study Chinese for one year (supported by the CSC) and pass the required score of HSK4 or HSK5 before commencing the major study. 2. Applicants for English-taught programs are required to provide proof of English proficiency of TOEFL ibt 80 or IELTS 6.0 overall or above.
Application Period	DEC 15th - MARCH 15th
Approval &Notification	The university will review the application documents and decide the nominated candidates before the end of May. The list of nominated candidates will be sent to the CSC for further review and final approval. Before the end of July, Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) will be sent out from the university to the approved scholarship winners.
Notes	 All the documents should be bound together on the top left corner in the order of 1 to 10 in ONE set; All the documents should be in <u>Chinese or English</u>; The highest diploma and academic transcripts must be notarized in <u>Chinese or English</u>; Majors related to English or other foreign language and literature are not supported by this scholarship program; Applicants with incomplete or inauthentic application documents or with majors unavailable at CUG will not be considered; All the documents will not be returned; Available majors in CUG can be checked via: http://iec.cug.edu.cn/English/Home.htm; Admission documents will be sent to the "permanent address" written on the application form.
